Bandhavgarh National Park

Situated in the Central Indian State of Madhya Pradesh, Bandhavgarh National Park has one of the highest densities of tigers on the subcontinent. It has a special significance as this sprawling wildlife reserve is the last home of the endangered White Tiger and an integral part of Project Tiger. Many believe this is one of India's most beautiful national parks as it has several dramatic landscape features: tropical forests, woodlands, steep rocky hills, valleys and even large areas of flat grasslands! Indeed, at this park – nature is at its best. Bandhavgarh National Park provides a natural habitat for around than 22 species of mammals, 70 species of butterflies and 255 species of birds. Interestingly the dense forest area of this park was once the private game reserve of the Maharajas of Rewa.
