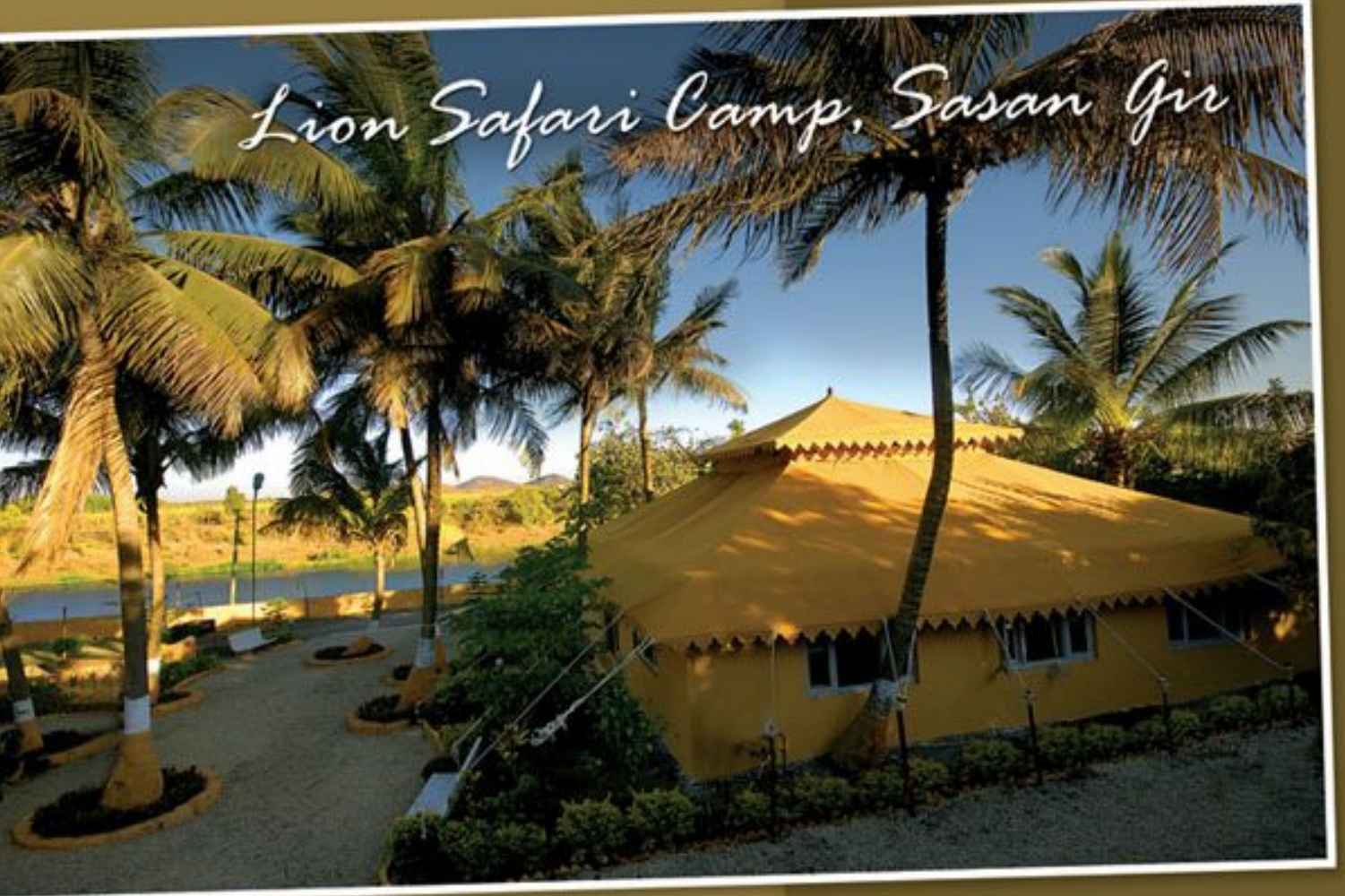


Lion Safari Camp, Sasan Gir



Gir National Park

Gir - the largest tract of dry deciduous forests in the semi-arid western part of India is the last remaining bastion of the Asiatic Lions. It's also the only place in the world where the Asiatic lions can be seen in their natural habitat. The Lion Sanctuary Project was begun to create a balance between the endangered lions and the nomadic Maldhari tribe. From the 20 lions at the turn of the century, there are now over 400 royal beasts that walk the Park. Today, Gir is one of the best-protected sanctuaries in India. It also has the highest population of Leopards compared to any other national park in India, making it one of the best places to spot the Big Cats. The Unique ecosystem of Gir harbors about 38 species of mammals, around 300 species of birds, 37 species of reptiles and more than 2000 species of insects.
